

## Contract

Offered by God  
Beginning of Time

Offered to Earth  
March 20, 6 B.C.

In pursuit of kindness, justice, righteousness, and truth to be provided by Creator God to all Creation including the inhabitants of Earth, the Creator agrees to the following terms:

- 1) **Forgiveness:** Every sin and blasphemy by the creature against The Creator and The Creator's Son will be forgiven by The Creator, but blasphemy against The Creator's Holy Spirit will not be forgiven.
- 2) **Eternal Life:** Whoever believes in The Creator's Son has eternal life. The creature can no longer die, because the creature has crossed over from death to life. Because The Creator's Son lives, the creature also will live.
- 3) **Intercession:** The creature who believes in The Creator's Son becomes a member of The Creator's family. That creature will not be condemned, but judged as innocent because that creature accepted the flesh and blood of The Creator's only begotten Son. That creature may ask The Creator for anything according to the name of The Creator's Son, and The Creator will do it because the creature has believed in The Creator's one-and-only begotten Son. This belief constitutes acceptable service by the creature, and The Creator's Son becomes the creature's Righteousness and Salvation as the creature's Intercessor.

This contract takes effect as soon as The Creator's Son accomplishes the work set forth by his Father. The Son will be on Earth as a servant and will seek the lost, heal the wounded, restore the weary, raise the dead, forgive the sinners, preach the good news to the poor, and proclaim the year of The Lord's favor. At The Creator's command, The Creator's Son will seek, rescue, teach, purify, freely and generously give and work, and lead justice to victory in fulfillment of The Scriptures.

Both The Creator and the creature will not legally challenge this contract. This contract is bound by the flesh and blood of The Creator's Son. This contract may not be adulterated, altered, amended, annulled, argued, constrained, corrected, corrupted, deceived, defamed, defeated, defended, delayed, deleted, demoralized, denied, destroyed, disgraced, dishonored, disproven, disputed, ended, envied, expired, fabricated, faked, falsified, fooled, forged, forgotten, forsaken, hindered, ignored, improved, joked, killed, libeled, lied-about, limited, lost, maligned, misconstrued, misrepresented, negated, negotiated, over-enforced, perpetuated, perverted, provoked, put-off, re-conceived, recovered, reinterpreted, rejected, removed, replaced, rescheduled, rescinded, restated, revoked, rewritten, sampled, set aside, stalled, stolen, terminated, torn, undermined, usurped, or violated. This contract is eternally permanent. "Heaven and Earth will all pass away, but my words will never pass away."

Any questions about the purpose or reason for this contract may be asked by the creature and answered by The Creator, although it should suffice that The Creator says this contract is necessary.
